July 2002 FAQ: Should I learn .Net or Java technology? Which one will be better for my career?

Answer:

Two platforms will dominate e-business-oriented application development efforts over the next five years: Microsoft and Java. There will probably not be a clear and decisive winner, both will survive and be viable platforms in our computing future. 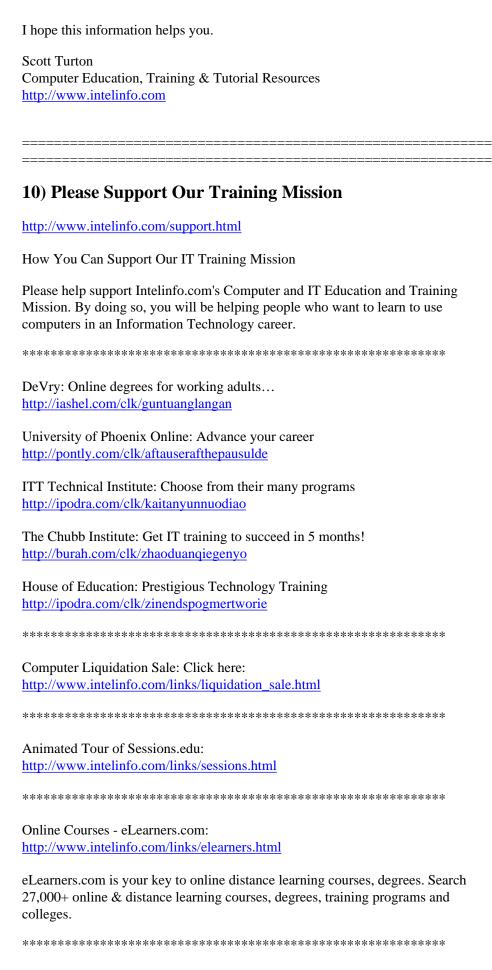
